BACK ON TRACK

- The Charlottesville Tom Sox won their first game of the 2025 season on Tuesday night in Waynesboro, taking care of the Generals, 10-9
- The 'Sox used a six-run eighth inning to erase a five-run deficit and earn the comeback victory
- Patrick Niehus (Gardner-Webb) got the scoring started in the eighth with a bases-clearing double to score three runs
- Hudson Lutterman (Virginia Tech) added an RBI single, and then RBI walks from Jesus Cesari (Southeast Arkansas) and Kyle Langley (James Madison) gave the 'Sox the lead, which they didn't give up
- Tim Lawson (North Carolina), Gian De Castro (Arizona State) and Trevor Booton (Auburn) all made their season debuts, and each played an important role
- · Lawson earned the start, and went two innings giving up two runs on two hits
- . De Castro didn't get a hit, but he walked twice and made some stellar plays at the hot corner
- . Booton pitched in a game for the first time since July 19, 2024, and earned the win, going two innings and only allowing one run on three hits
- · Charlottesville also walked 14 times in Tuesday's win, the second most in a single game in franchise history
- · Every Tom Sox starter reached base safely, with both Langley and Niehus each reaching base safely three times

10TH SEASON OF TOM SOX BASEBALL

- 2025 marks the tenth season of Charlottesville Tom Sox baseball
- Since 2015, the team's inaugural season, the 'Sox have won four Valley League Championships, appeared in the championship series six times, and been a step in over 30 professional player's journeys
- Over the last decade, the Tom Sox have won 254 games, and have a winning percentage of .602

RETURNING 'SOX

- The Tom Sox are excited to welcome back three players from last year's Valley League title team back to CHO Airport Field at Charlottesville High School
- James Nunnallee (Virginia), Kaegan Costa (Paul D Camp CC), and Trevor Booton (Auburn) were all on last year's team, and are on this year's Opening Day roster

COAST TO COAST

- Charlottesville's active roster features 26 players from Division I and three Junior College players across 15 conferences in college baseball
- The 'Sox are from eight states across the country (Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, Maryland, North Carolina, Pennsylvania, Virginia), with Virginia being the most represented (14 players)

SCOUTING THE CARDINALS

- Front Royal comes to Charlottesville after dropping Tuesday's contest against New Market, 9-3
- The Cardinals won their first two games of the season against Purcellville and Covington
- Jay Campbell is leading the charge for the Cardinals offense, hitting for a .455 AVG, with a HR, 2B and 4 RBI
- Campbell holds the team lead in AVG, OPS, Hits, HR, and RBI, while being tied for the team lead in 2B, HBP and SB
- Pitching wise, as a team, the Cardinals sport the third-best ERA in the Valley League at 4.33
- Tonight's game is the 26th overall meeting between Charlottesville and Front Royal, with the 'Sox winning 19 of the first 25
- The last time these two teams clashed was in the first round of the 2023 Valley League Playoffs, when the 'Sox won game three of the series, 4-2, ending Front Royal's season

COACHES CORNER

- Randy Tomlin, the reigning VBL South Division Coach of the Year, returns to Charlottesville for his second season at the helm of the Tom Sox
- Last season, Tomlin became the third Tom Sox head coach to earn Coach of the Year honors, joining Corey Hunt (2017) and Kory Koehler (2021)
- Tomlin led the 'Sox to a 30-15 overall record in his first season, a league-best 26-13 regular season record, and the fourth Valley Baseball League Championship in team history
- Tomlin is also the current head coach at Liberty Christian
 Academy
- Under Tomlin, the Tom Sox finished top three in the VBL in batting average, runs scored, ERA and WHIP during the regular season
- Randy's son, Coy Tomlin, also returns for his second season as an assistant coach, where he will continue to bring infectious energy to the ballpark each night
- Assistant coaches Thomas Abell, Jim Darin, Joey Davis (Hitting), and Chris Glaize (Pitching) round out the 2025 staff
- Darin, previously on Corey Hunt's staff from 2017-2019, rejoins the staff after three trips to the Valley League Championship
- Davis, the hitting coach, is a two-time World Series champion, spent 10 years as a major league scout for the Toronto Blue Jays, Philadelphia Phillies, and Atlanta Braves, and has previously coached at Berry College, St. Leo College, Western Kentucky, as well as both the Blue Jays and Phillies organizations
- Glaize, the pitching coach, is currently the head coach at Brookville High School in Lynchburg, VA, and has previously served as an assistant coach for the Purcellville Cannons and Winchester Royals

A JAM-PACKED SCHEDULE

- The Valley Baseball League and Charlottesville Tom Sox have announced exciting changes for the 2025 schedule
- Inter-division play returns this season as part of the 42game slate, with every team playing each team in their own division six times (three home and three road), and every team in the other division twice (one home and one road)
- Another exciting change this season revolves around the brand-new playoff format, which grants a playoff berth to all 12 teams
- The top two seeds in each division will receive a first-round bye, while seeds 3-6 play their preliminary singleelimination game, then the remaining teams will play out the quarterfinal and semifinal games in order to determine who punches each division's ticket to the championship, which remains a three-game series

A MAGICAL 2024

- It was a magical season in Charlottesville a year ago, as the Tom Sox brought home the VBL title for the fourth time in franchise history
- · Throughout the regular season, the 'Sox were stellar, as

- they secured their second consecutive VBL regular season crown, finishing 0.5 games ahead of Purcellville at 26-13 on the year
- They carried home a division title for the fourth straight season, winning the South by four games over Harrisonburg
- The Tom Sox rolled through June with relative ease, going 17-4, scoring in double-digits in nine of those 21 games
- The 'Sox felt more adversity in July as rosters began to turn over, but they never lost consecutive games until after they locked up the division title
- Colby Wallace (East Carolina) paced Charlottesville's offense in the regular season, winning the league batting title with a .470 batting average
- He added a team-leading .464 on-base percentage and also ranked among the league's best in slugging percentage (.489)
- Including the playoffs, Wallace hit for a team-best .348 batting average, tallied 10 extra base hits, and drove in 22 runs
- Ryan Wynn (Wofford) and Robbie Lavey (George Washington) also put forth impressive seasons
- Lavey paced the team among active players with six home runs (including playoffs), while Wynn ranked among the league's top five sluggers with seven doubles, three triples, a home run, and a .467 slugging percentage
- A variety of arms led the 'Sox throughout the year, including Chase Stryker, who held a 2.27 ERA in 35.2 innings, and James Hays (Stetson) who carried a 3.94 ERA in 32 innings
- Trevor Booton (Auburn), Daniel Powell, (Kennesaw State), Ryan Grzesiak (Florida Southwestern), Bobby Olsen (Villanova), and Will Pearson (lowa) were among those making the biggest impacts out of the bullpen
- In the South Division Championship Series, Culpeper took game one, 4-1, putting the 'Sox in elimination mode
- In response to the game one loss, the 'Sox put up 27 runs across the next two games, winning game two, 8-1, and game three, 19-2 in seven innings
- The 19 runs scored in game three is a Tom Sox playoff record, and tied the franchise record for most runs scored in a game.
- In the Valley League Championship Series against Purcellville, the Tom Sox and Cannons put on a show
- In game one, the Cannons led 5-3 in the bottom of the eighth, but Robbie Lavey (George Washington) came up clutch with a two-run single to tie the game
- In extras, Sam Mummau (Jacksonville) blasted a walk-off two run homer to give the 'Sox a 1-0 series lead
- · Game two was a much different story for the 'Sox though
- Charlottesville scored seven runs in its first two at-bats, but then Purcellville responded to that deficit with 21 unanswered runs, and evened the series with a 21-8 run-rule win
- In the deciding game three, it was the Cannons taking an early lead, holding a 4-0 advantage going into the bottom of the fifth
- The Tom Sox responded with a six-run fifth, highlighted by RBI singles from Colby Wallace (East Carolina) and Caden Ferraro (Blinn)
- Chase Stryker limited the Cannons offense in the middle innings, and Cooper Blauser's two-run homer in the eighth provided the insurance Charlottesville needed
- Daniel Powell struck out the side in the ninth, sealing the fourth Valley League Championship in Charlottesville Tom Sox franchise history

'SOX ON THE ROAD TO OMAHA

- 24 former Tom Sox competed in this year's NCAA
 Tournament with their eyes set on reaching the College
 World Series in Omaha, NE
- The 'Sox were represented in 10 of the 16 NCAA Regionals across the country, including six players playing in the Conway Regional hosted by Coastal Carolina
- Several 'Sox thrived during Regionals, which you can read more about here.
- Eight of those players (John Armstrong Auburn, Cade

Belyeu - Auburn, Dean Mihos - Coastal Carolina, Zach Root - Arkansas, Cale Stricklin - Auburn, Justin Thomas -Arkansas, Derek Williams - Miami) advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals, which start on Friday

'SOX IN THE PROS

- Four former Tom Sox are currently playing in the majors (Connor Gillispie - Marlins, Vinnie Pasquantino - Royals, Carson Spiers - Reds, Wyatt Langford - Rangers)
- · Gillispie, Pasquantino, and Spiers all played for Charlottesville in 2017 when the 'Sox won their first VBL title, while Langford played for the Tom Sox in 2021
- The 'Sox also have 29 former players currently playing Minor League Baseball
- Kyle Nicolas, who pitched for Charlottesville in 2018, made his MLB Debut with the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2023, and has appeared in 62 games

 Nicolas is currently playing for the Pirates AAA affiliate, the Indianapolis Indians

A WINNING MODEL

- The Tom Sox have been the Valley League's most
- successful team since winning their first title in 2017
- The 'Sox have appeared in all but one championship series since 2017 and have won the league title in four of the last seven seasons
- Charlottesville's 190-99 record since the start of the 2017 season is the best in the VBL
- · Charlottesville's seven championship appearances and four titles since 2017 are both the most in the VBL over that snan
- . The Tom Sox have won the VBL title in alternating seasons since 2017 ('17, '19, '22 (2020 season cancelled), '24)




